



## Scholarship Guidelines

Scholarships currently are \$1,000 for one year. Students can apply for a second year, but usually only one scholarship is awarded in a calendar year. The scholarship is available to Juniors, Seniors, graduate students and first year doctoral candidates residing in St. Lucie County only. Sophomores may apply for the junior year.

### Applicant Eligibility:

Applicants must meet all the following criteria.

Must be a US citizen, providing birth certificate copy, or US passport.

Must be a full-time college student with a minimum of 12 graded hours for undergraduate or 9 graded hours for graduate student.

Must have cumulative GPA 3.5 on a 4.0 scale.

Must be planning a career related to gardening, landscaping design, environment issues, floral design or horticulture.

Must be majoring in one of the following fields: Agronomy, Agriculture Education: Floriculture; Horticulture; Landscaping Design; Botany; Biology; Forestry; Wildlife Science; Plant Pathology/Science; City Planning; Habitat or Forest Systems Ecology; Aquaculture; Environmental Concerns; Horticulture Resources/Environmental Conservation (including Engineering, etc.); Land management.

Applications are evaluated and winners chosen by Fort Pierce Garden Club Scholarship Committee.
